St. Joseph High School continues to be a vibrant Catholic institution where students are nurtured spiritually, academically and socially on a daily basis.

- Ten SJHS students attended the Martin Luther King Day Breakfast at Stockton College sponsored by the American Conference on Diversity, Atlantic County Chapter.
